Jamie (not real name) is a 4 year old boy in need of a foster care placement in the Donegal area. Jamie likes to paint, colour and play with playdoh and building blocks. He also enjoys singing nursery rhymes. Jamie has complex care needs, he has a diagnosis of autism and attends speech and language therapy.
