Bambinelli Sunday 2024

During the Seasons of Advent and Christmas, many of us display the Nativity scene in our homes. This custom showing the birth of Christ owes its origin to St. Francis of Assisi, who made the First Christmas Crib for Christ on Christmas Eve in 1223. Pope Saint John Paul II began the tradition of Bambinelli Sunday to remind families about the joyous event of Baby Jesus' arrival in the manger. Bambinelli Sunday is celebrated on the Third Sunday of Advent. On that day children gather with their families in St. Peter's Square in Rome and bring figures of Baby Jesus from their family's Nativity scene. During the noontime Angelus prayer, Pope Francis blesses the children and the figurines they have brought.
