Changes to weekend parish Schedule of Masses

In Keeping with the call for 'rationalisation' of Masses and preparing for structural changes in our Diocese to utilise the fewer priests of the future in the best possible way, and in deep consultation with our parish pastoral council, we have decided that from after the mission and beginning on the weekend of the 7th & 8th June, there will only be one Sunday Mass in our parish. It has become clear that with the drop in attendance at our services that two Masses each weekend will be more than sufficient for those who wish to practice their faith. So from this date, the Saturday Mass remains as is, alternating between Kincasslagh and Burtonport monthly, and the Sunday Mass will be in the other Church only. So for example. The Saturday Mass in June is in Kincasslagh, therefore the Sunday Mass will be in St. Columba's. Then in July, the Saturday vigil will revert to St. Columba's, and the Sunday Mass will be in St.

Also the practice of reserving a Mass for one intention has become unsustainable and we are following our neighbouring parishes where multiple intentions will be accepted for each weekend Mass. In this scenario, a single Mass will be offered for each intention at a later date either by ourselves in the parish, or sent to mission priests to say when they can. So while you give an intention for an anniversary Mass or a months mind, and go to that Mass, you will hear the intention read along with various others, but it will be the duty of the priest to ensure that an individual Mass is offered afterwards for each intention received.
