NOVENA TO THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS: As part of a Novena to the Sacred Heart being held on nine

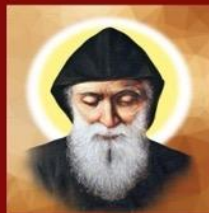
