Gemma's Legacy of Hope is a community-led initiative rooted in Dungloe, created to support the mental health and wellbeing of individuals living and working throughout The Rosses area of Co. Donegal. Up to the end of November 2025, Gemma's Legacy of Hope continued to offer vital counselling and play therapy services from our house in Dungloe. Made possible by the generosity, fundraising, and ongoing support of the local community, we were able to cover all running costs and fund three professional counsellors in partnership with the Pastoral Counselling Service in Letterkenny. Together, we are ensuring accessible, compassionate support remains available close to home for children, young people, and adults who need it.

This year, (to end of Nov 2025) 707 counselling and play therapy sessions were delivered:

- 216 for adults
- 491 for children and adolescents

The service costs approximately €70,000 per year, with €4,822 funded by Tusla and the remainder raised through incredible local fundraising efforts.

We are deeply grateful to all who organised and supported fundraisers in 2025 — including community groups, local swimmers, schools, clubs, businesses, individuals, anonymous donors, and those who donated via iDonate. Special thanks also to those currently supporting ongoing fundraisers, including 12 Dips for December and the CLG Donegal Dubai

fundraiser. Thank you for helping us support healing, hope, and wellbeing in our community.
